

Excerpt from Kremlin Target: U. S. A : Conquest by Propaganda Eleven and one-half years have passed since the Kremlin-imposed regime in Romania closed my office and forced me to leave the country. And twelve years have passed since my Romanian secretary was thrown into jail and given a sentence of fifteen years of hard labor for treason because she worked for the Americans. My professional life was changed by this experience. I found that accommodation with the Russians was impossible and cultural relations for purposes of good will were futile. The USSR was dedicated to world domination through the imposition of dictatorial totalitarianism on one free country after another. I found, too, that - as pointed out by De Tocqueville one hundred and twenty-six years ago - the basis for this dedication lay in the traditional, historical Russian relationship between the ruler and the ruled, rather than in communism which is simply one, recently created, outlet of national expansion used as a facade for propaganda aggression. So I was forced to switch from cultural-information representative of the United States to propagandist, from a person trying to cultivate cordial relations for my country to a competitor in a new arena of international conflict. This shift was accomplished during the first year of my assignment in Bucharest, when my staff tried to compete, like David, against the Goliath of the Kremlin propaganda apparatus.
